Departure:

Food:

Please could you provide a packed lunch for your child for Tuesday 20th February. This should only contain the normal food that they would have at school e.g. no sweets or chocolate. There should be no nuts or nut based food of any description. Please can you make sure you do not provide any other food or snacks. We will provide plenty of snacks for the children when needed and the centre will provide the main meals. This will help us to keep everybody safe throughout the trip.

Pupil Kit List

Please bear in mind that we are in a windy and exposed location. It is expected that on visits most of the day will be spent outdoors – so make sure you have lots of warm clothes, layers and waterproofs! It is recommended that no jewellery is worn throughout the visit. All towels and bed linen are provided.

Essential items:
